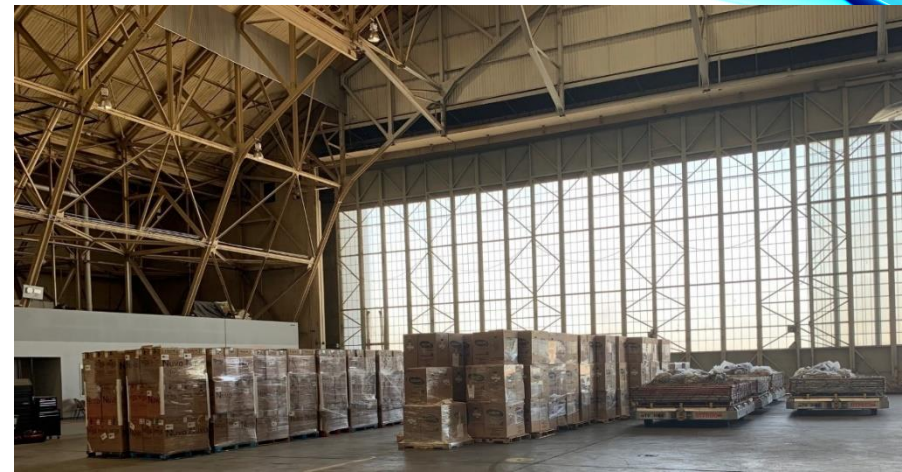

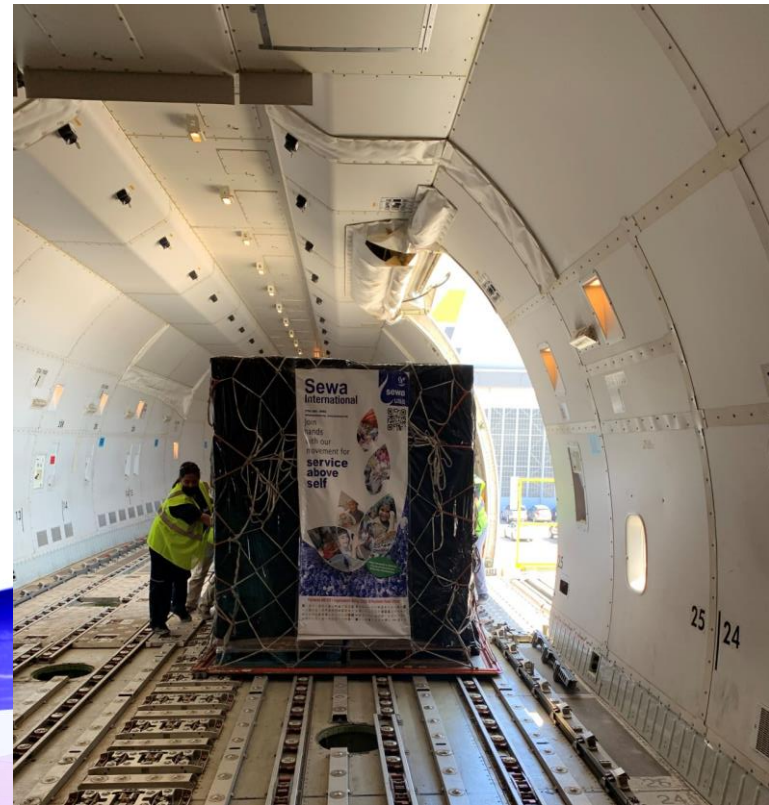
FedEx provided all the necessary equipment to ensure the humanitarian aid could be loaded efficiently.





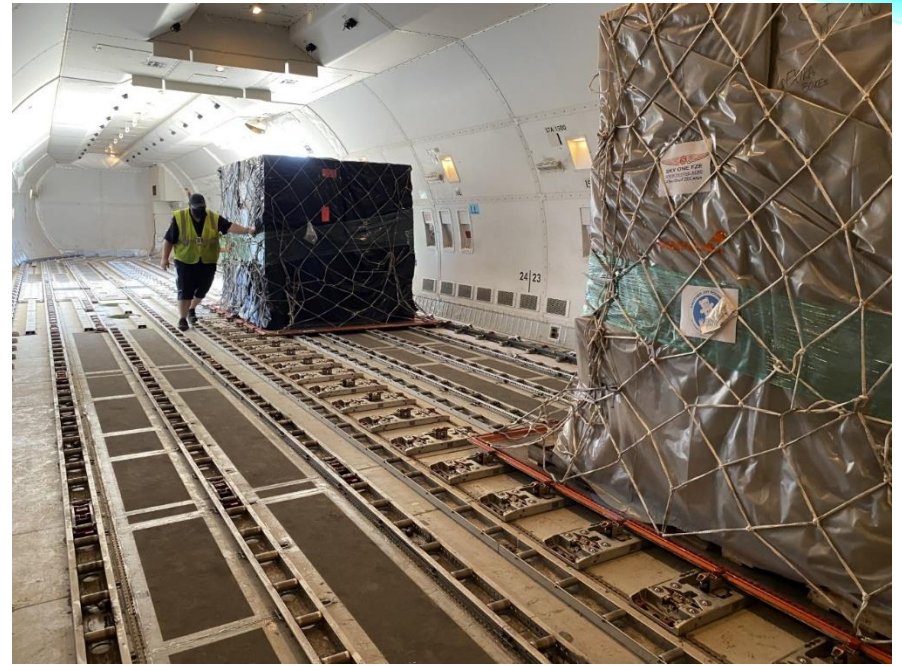

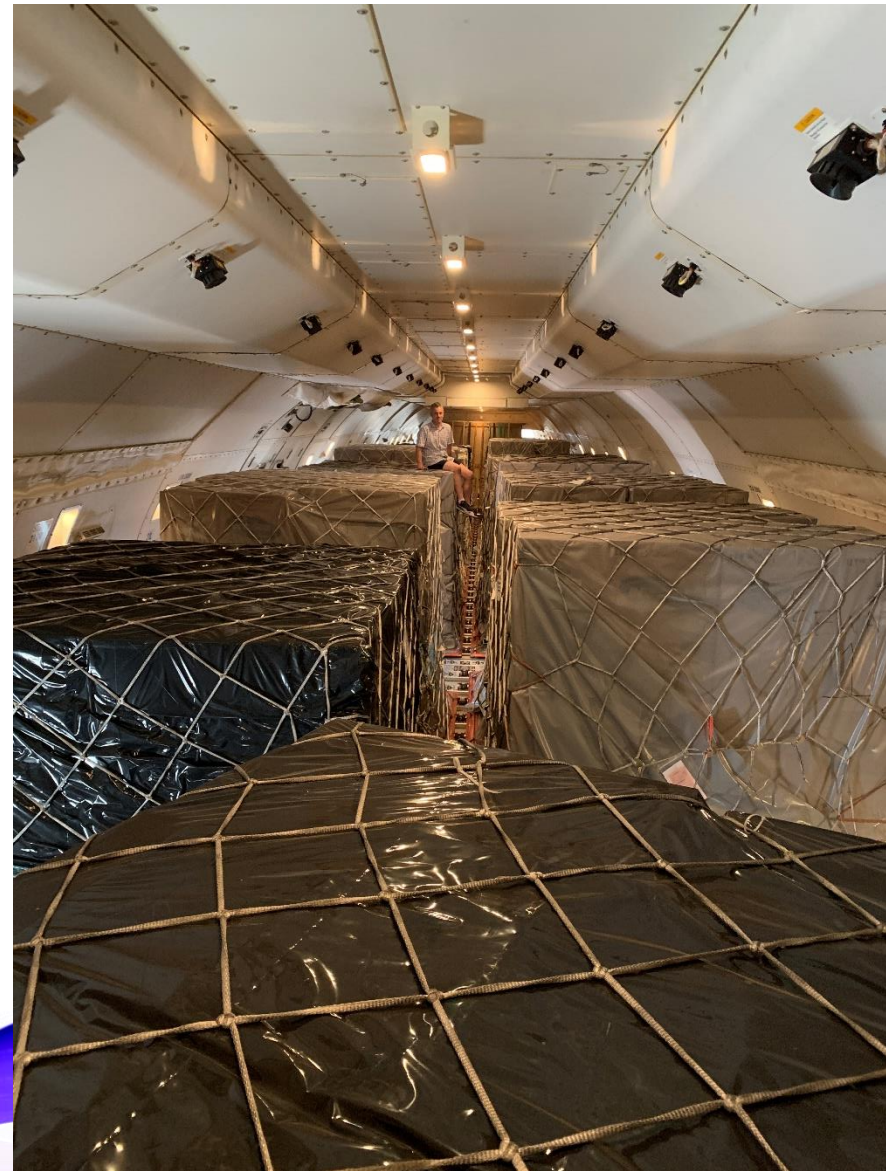


Cargo Loading Video

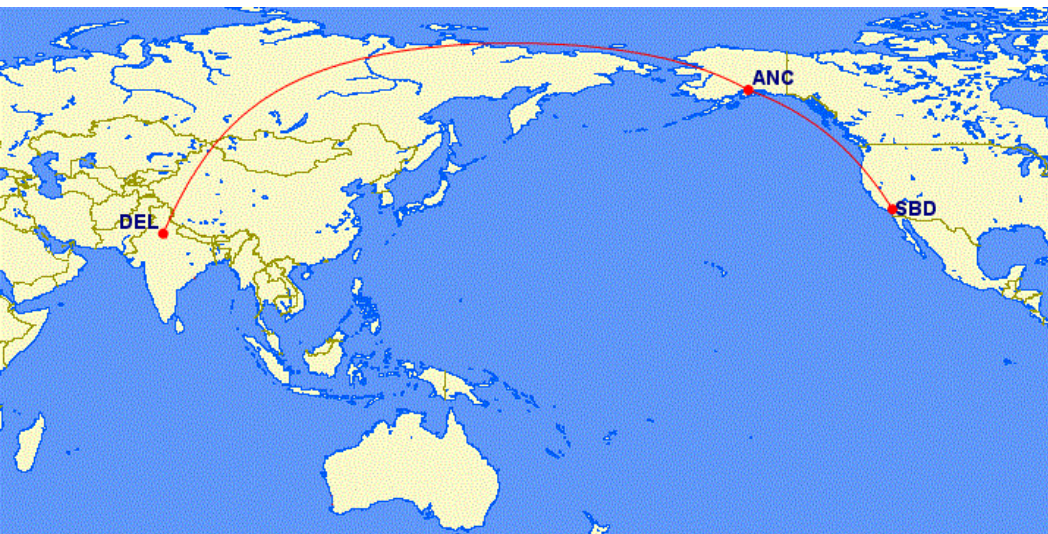




Aircraft loaded & ready for takeoff...



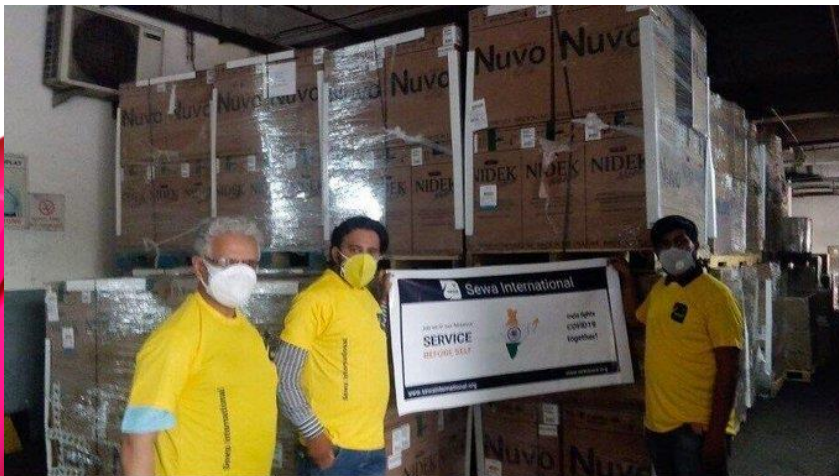
